50th **Anniversary of the closure of Notre Dame Convent School.** In the 18th century, Sisters of Notre Dame (Namur) - a Teaching Order founded by St. Julie Billiart, arrived in this country to provide education for Catholic girls, by establishing Convent Schools. One of which was in Abington Street in Northampton town centre. Sadly, the school closed in 1975, pupils were moved to a new purpose built mixed R.C. school, and the beloved building and chapel were destroyed, and the grounds built over - with only the Sister's Cemetery left as a reminder of their presence. A Mass in recognition of the Sisters historic role in providing a Catholic education to Northampton school girls and the closure of the Convent School, is being held at the Cathedral, on Saturday 19th July at 12noon. This will be followed by a reception in the St. Thomas Centre in the Cathedral grounds, allowing former pupils to meet up, and reminisce. If you were a Notre Dame pupil or know someone who was, please come or let them know about the Mass.

A Time to Listen. "There is a need and duty for us to listen to those who have been hurt by abuse and are suffering. It is humbling for me as the Bishop to listen to victims and survivors.
